Houses have doors to keep people out, walkways are separated from streets in height, pedestrian crossing are specially marked with colour...

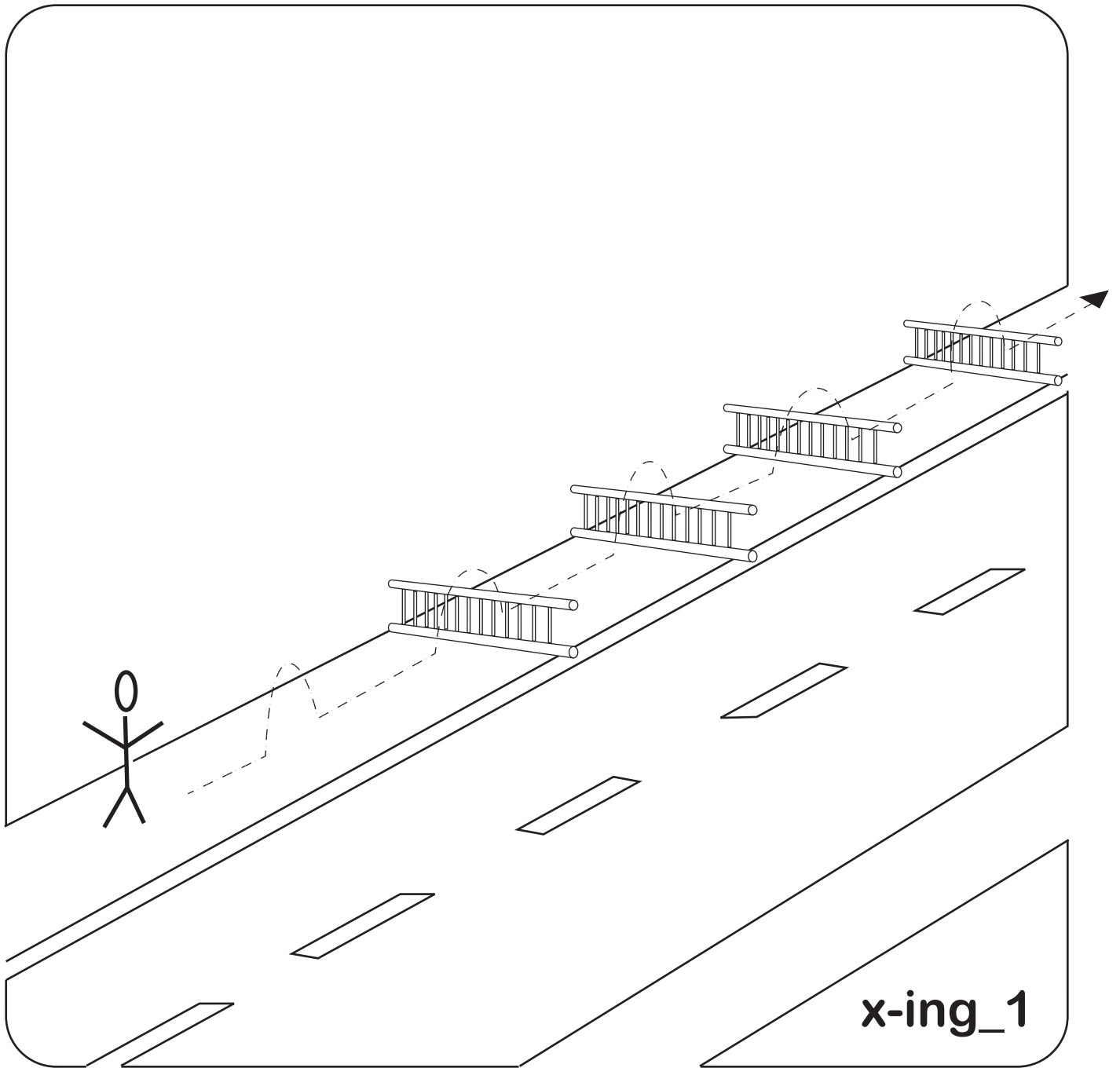
Crossing borders can be physical as well as psychological.

The four ladder x-ing should break through our unconsciousness and show borders, we not used to see them anymore.

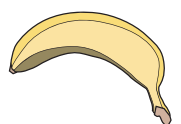

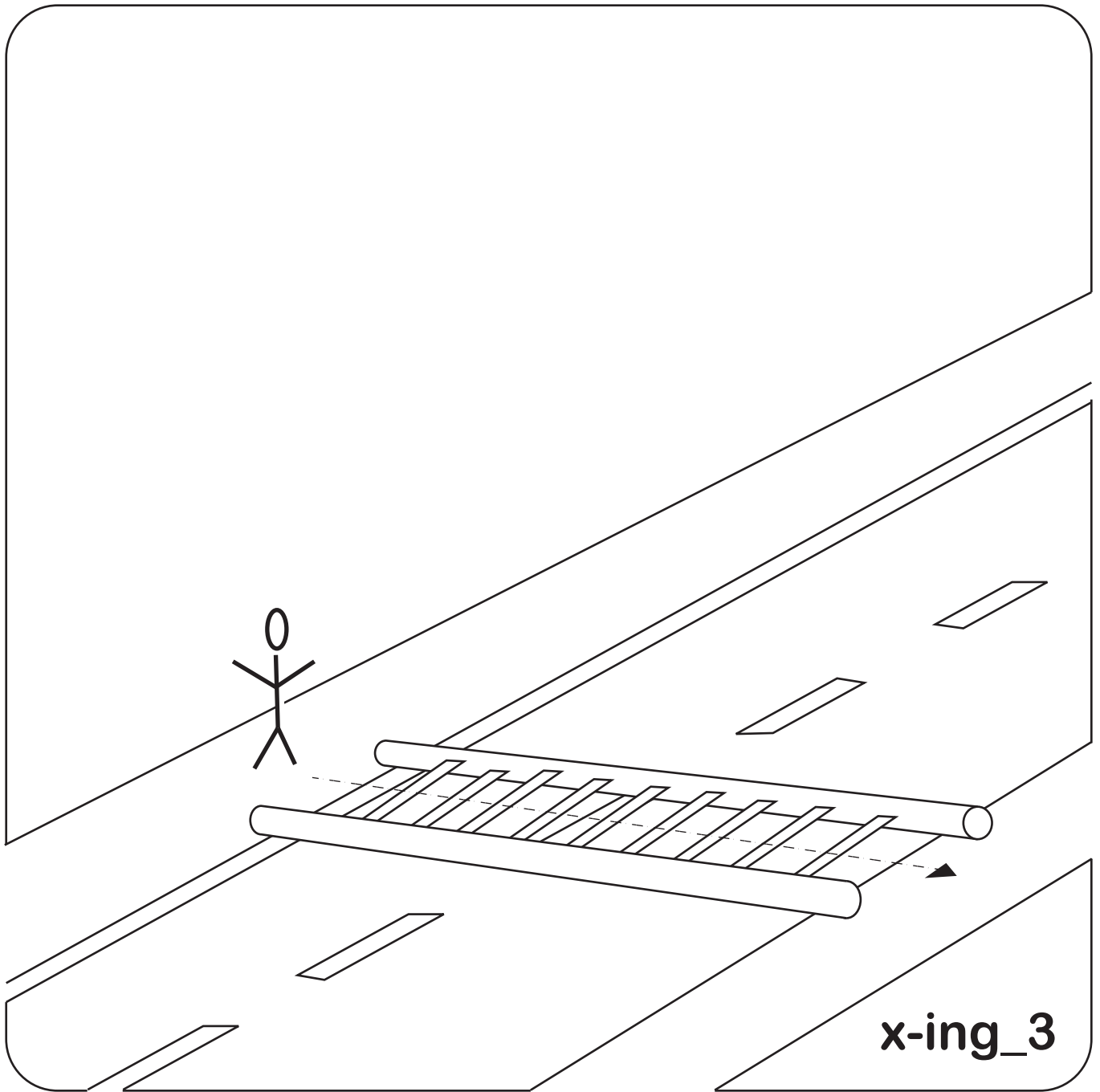
1 sidewalk  
4 ladders



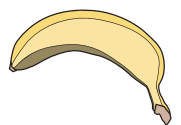


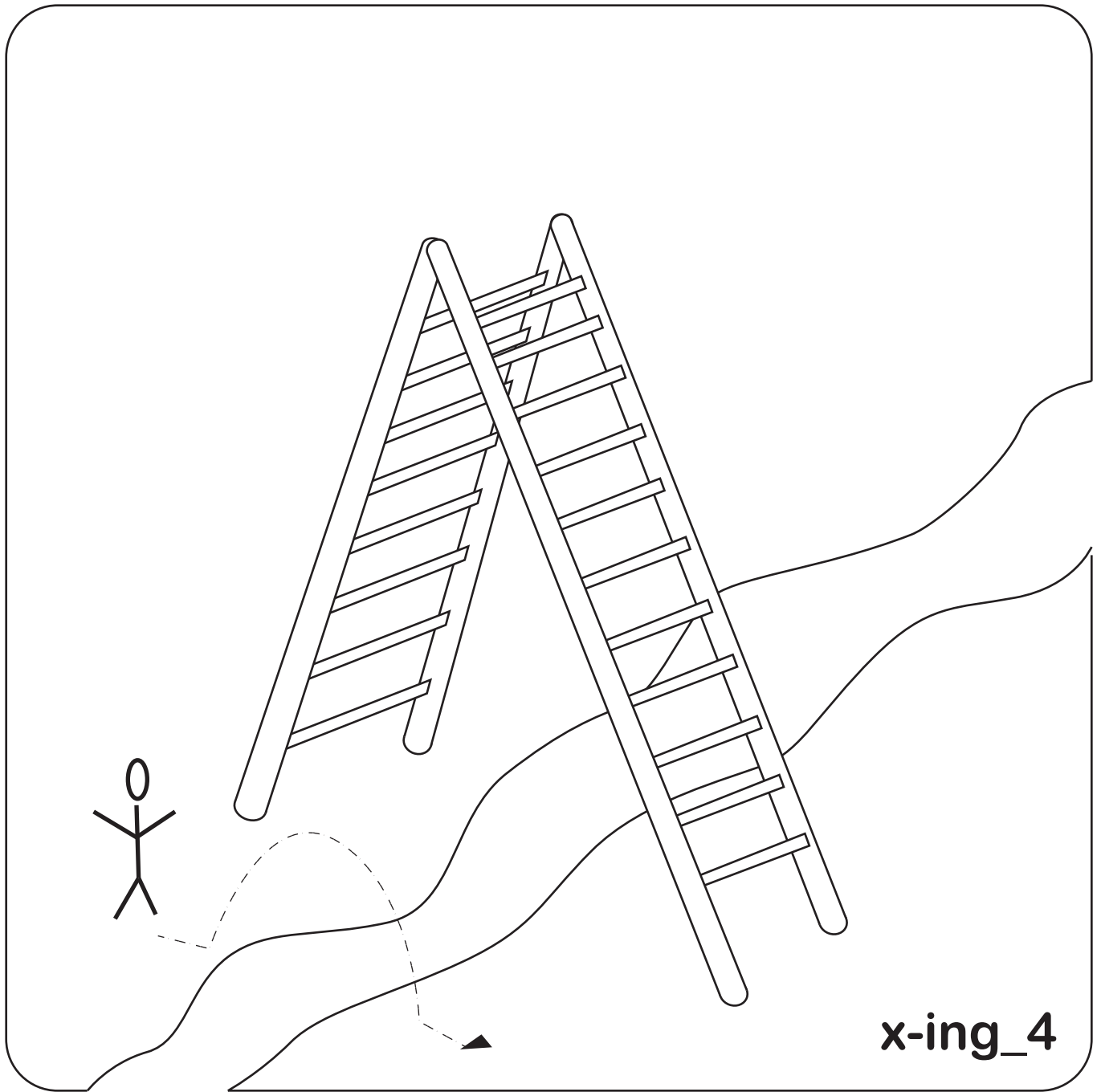
**2 sidewalks**
